## **Security Bank receives Cornerstone Award**

AUSTIN, April 16, 2015 – The Texas Bankers Foundation, the philanthropic arm of the Texas Bankers Association, presented a Cornerstone Award to Midland-based Security Bank for fighting hunger in its communities. Leah Wilson, Public Relations Specialist, accepted the award today at the Texas Bankers Association's 131st Annual Convention held in Austin.

Security Bank employees volunteered at the West Texas Food Bank, the San Antonio Food Bank and small churches in rural towns by gathering food, preparing meals and packing food to distribute to individuals. In 2014, Security Bank collected a total of 1,740 pounds of food and raised more than \$12,300 in donations. The combination of the canned goods and donations provided more than 50,000 meals to those in need. The bank also participated as a corporate donor by sponsoring two large fundraisers for the West Texas Food Bank.

This is the 13th year the Texas Bankers Foundation has recognized Texas banks for their outstanding community involvement through the Cornerstone Award competition. Projects have included neighborhood and housing development, small business and industrial development, main street revitalization, community celebrations and support of music or theater programs.
