Security Bank receives Cornerstone Award

HOUSTON, April 30, 2018 – The Texas Bankers Foundation, the philanthropic arm of the Texas Bankers Association, will present a Cornerstone Award to Midland-based Security Bank for its Fighting Hunger campaign. Leah Williams, PR & marketing specialist, will accept the award on Thursday at the Texas Bankers Association’s 134th Annual Convention at the Marriott Marquis in Houston.

In 2017, Security Bank’s Fighting Hunger campaign raised funds for the West Texas Food Bank during Hunger Action Month in September. Coincidentally, Hurricane Harvey arrived at the launch of the campaign. The devastation caused by the hurricane required much-needed aid from the West Texas Food Bank, leaving their supplies low for serving West Texas residents.

Security Bank raised funds by selling raffle tickets at their branches for a chance to win a one-night stay at the JW Marriott in San Antonio and a \$500 gift card.

Raffle ticket sales brought in \$3,600 in donations and Security Bank presented a \$10,000 check to the Food Bank at the end of the campaign. The donation enabled the West Texas Food Bank to provide 40,000 meals to those in need.

This is the 16th year the Texas Bankers Foundation has recognized Texas banks for their outstanding community involvement through the Cornerstone Award competition. Projects have included neighborhood and housing development, small business and industrial development, main street revitalization, community celebrations and support of music or theater programs.
